What is a BIA?

A Business Improvement Area (BIA) is a not-for-profit association of the property owners and businesses in a geographic district within a municipality. The BIA is managed by a volunteer Board of Management. The Board of Management is comprised of property owners, businesses and at least one member of municipal council.

Every business within the BIA area is automatically included in the BIA membership and contributes to the BIA budget through a special levy (tax). The levy is paid by the property owners and businesses within the boundary. The Board of Management establishes the budget every year which is approved by the BIA membership then submitted to City Council.



Our Goals

All BIA's have the same goal – to encourage more traffic and ultimately increase traffic and sales in their downtown business district. The BIA acts as a unifying body for its membership, local business people and property owners. Working together with the support of the municipality to make their BIA a "destination" and not only for its retailers and restaurants but its professional and cultural assets as well.

The Waterfront District's priority areas continue to focus on maintaining essential services to all its members, and being a partner in addressing downtown development and growth including:

- Revitalizing the downtown area through regular maintenance, façade improvements, streetscape and public art programs, special events and seasonal decorations, business recruitment, promotions and municipal partnership.
- Promoting the district as a place to conduct business, live, work, play and stay.
